Lake Charlie Capps Renovation**

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks in a meeting at Wall Doxey State Park on November 21, 2005, under authority of Section 25-43-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent adopt the following regulations relative to all state lakes owned and/or managed by the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. This is done under the authority of Section 49-1-29 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 as follows:

Lake Charlie Capps in Bolivar County is scheduled for renovation. In order to complete renovation, the lake will be drained. No size limits or creel limits will be enforced on any species of fish taken from Lake Charlie Capps during the draining.

Be it ordered that following the draining, Lake Charlie Capps shall be closed to fishing at such time as scheduled by the Bureau of Fisheries. Appropriate signage shall be placed at all access points to the lake informing the public of the closure.
