

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks in a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on February 21, 2006, under authority of Section 25-43-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt the following regulations relative to possession limit on game fish. This is done under the authority of Section 49-1-29, 49-7-41 and 49-7-53 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 as follows:


No person shall take in any one calendar day, no more than the daily creel or bag limit of game fish. No person shall at any time, by any means, or in any manner, transport more than seven (7) daily creel or bag limits of game fish for each person present in the vehicle. A single angler may only transport his or her own limit(s) of game fish, not to exceed seven (7) daily limits.

Anyone wishing to comment on the above proposed action may do so in writing to the Executive Director, Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, 1505 Eastover Drive, Jackson, MS 39211 no later than March 21, 2006.
