Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: Clarify VR services for individuals requesting assistance with the cost of secondary alcohol and/or drug treatment; and to add the ability of the VR Counselor to request a drug test for applicants with a history of substance abuse who are seeking services for another disabling condition.
