Specific Legal Authority authorizing the promulgation of Rule: Sections 25-1-111 and 75-9-526 of Miss. Code Ann.
Reference to Rules repealed, amended or suspended by the Proposed Rule: Amended Rule 209 of "State of Mississippi Administrative Rules UCC-9 and Central Filing System"

Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: An amendment to Rule 209 is submitted to adhere to Section 25-1-111, which requires each state agency to take such steps as reasonably necessary to prevent the disclosure of individual social security numbers to the general public. As of August 1, 2006, Non-Food Security Act UCC filings will be rejected if they contain an individual's social security number. The changes to Rule 209 are intended to give filers immediate guidance relating to filling out the national form and clarify the Secretary of State's authority to redact social security numbers from UCC documents.
