
TO REPEAL PUBLIC NOTICE 3409

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on August 15, 2006, under authority of §25-43-3.103 Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to repeal the following regulation concerning revocation and reinstatement of hunting, trapping and fishing privileges following a conviction for a violation of MISS. CODE ANN. §49-7-95, as amended by Senate Bill 2898, Regular Session of the Mississippi State Legislature, 2005:


BE IT HEREBY ORDERED, THAT Public Notice #3409, effective August 30, 1994, is hereby repealed, in that the amendments to MISS. CODE ANN. §49-7-95 as enacted by Senate Bill 2898 of the Regular Session of 2005, have superseded and replaced the provisions of the regulation, rendering the regulation null and void.




