Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:
To modify the rule to make provisions for issuance of a temporary permit, in certain cases, for license applicants
who are already licensed in another state and are coming to MS to take a position as nursing home administrator.
The amendment also establishes procedures for an administrator licensed in another state to administer a MS
nursing home when the location of the nursing home is under a declared state of emergency by either Federal,
State or local government.
