
PUBLIC NOTICE W11-3462 (Emergency Amendment)

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on November 21, 2006, under authority of §25-43-3.103 and §25-43-3.108 Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its finding of imminent peril to the public health, safety, and welfare, in that the 2006-07 Red Creek Wildlife Management Area hunting regulations previously adopted contained certain terms and provisions that would negatively impact public safety. The Commission adopts this temporary rule, amending the problem sections of Public Notice W11-3462. The Commission adopts the following change concerning the 2006-07 Red Creek Wildlife Management Area hunting regulations due to the need for revision of portions of the area open to hunting. The following regulation is promulgated under authority of §49-1-29 and §49-5-13, Mississippi Code of 1972.

CLOSED AREA: All National Forest land within the area south of Forest Service Road 445, west of Railroad Creek, north of County Road 402 (Larue Road), and east of State Highway 15 is closed to all hunting.




