Reference to Rules repealed, amended or suspended by the Proposed Rule : Changes in the eligibility for admission to veterans homes policy, SVAB may set/revise daily charge for residents and change in asset amount for indigent veterans in the homes.

Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: Mississippi State Veterans Affairs Board's policy, rules and regulations are to be amended. Changes in Eligibility for admission to home. State Veterans Affairs Board may set/revise the daily charge for resident care in the State Veterans Homes. Change in the amount of assets for indigent veterans in the homes.
