



**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE ADOPTION**

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**Specific Legal Authority authorizing the promulgation of Rule:** Sections 79-4-1.22(24) and 79-4-1.30, and the Proclamations of the Governor issued on August 26, 2005 and continuing through January 12, 2007, pursuant to Section 33-15-11

**Reference to Rules repealed, amended or suspended by the Proposed Rule:** Rule provides a process for allowing the Secretary of State’s Office to administratively revoke administrative dissolutions and revocations for victims of hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

**Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:** The rule provides a process for allowing the Secretary of State’s Office to revoke the administrative dissolution/revocation of corporations victimized by the hurricanes, and thus avoid having burden those corporations with reinstatement fees.
