PUBLIC NOTICE NUMBER W12-3433

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, at a meeting in New Albany, Mississippi on April 12, 2007, under authority of Section 25-43-3.103, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent and thirty days thereafter did adopt the following **2007-2008 Small Game Hunting and Trapping Seasons and Bag Limits**. This was done under authority of Sections 49-1-29, 49-5-13 and 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

Be it ordered that Public Notice Number W11-3433a is hereby amended as follows:

FROG:

April 1, 2008 - September 30, 2008

BAG LIMIT: 25 POSSESSION LIMIT: 50

Only 25 may be taken in any one night. A valid hunting or fishing license is required.

RACCOON:

June 30, 2007 - September 30, 2007

BAG LIMIT: 1 per party per night

OPOSSUM, RACCOON, AND BOBCAT:

October 1, 2007 - October 31, 2007 (sport hunting with dogs and guns for food & sport)

BAG LIMIT: 5 per day; 8 per party POSSESSION LIMIT: 10

November 1, 2007 - February 28, 2008 (sport hunting with dogs and guns for food, sport, and pelt)

BAG LIMIT: No limit

SQUIRREL:

Zone 1: Areas north of Hwy. 82 plus those portions of Sunflower County and Washington County south of Hwy. 82.

September 29, 2007 - February 28, 2008

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day POSSESSION LIMIT: 16

Zone 2: Areas between Hwy. 82 and Hwy. 84 plus portions of the state south of Hwy. 84 and west of I-55.

October 13, 2007 - February 28, 2008

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day POSSESSION LIMIT: 16

Zone 3: Areas south of Hwy. 84 and east of I-55.

October 27, 2007 - February 28, 2008

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day POSSESSION LIMIT: 16

Youth Squirrel Hunts** (Private Lands Only)

Zone 1 - September 22 - September 28, 2007

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Zone 2 - October 6 - October 12, 2007

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Zone 3 - October 20 - October 26, 2007

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

** Youth eligible to participate in this special hunt are those 15 years of age and younger. Each youth must be in the immediate vicinity and under the direct supervision of an adult 21 years of age or older. Furthermore, if the child is under the age of twelve (12), the supervising adult must be a licensed or exempt hunter.

U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service and U. S. Army Corps of Engineers managed lands:

These lands are authorized to provide youth squirrel hunting opportunities on days designated by Federal Regulations. Contact local National Wildlife Refuge or Corps of Engineers managers for details.

BOBWHITE QUAIL:

November 22, 2007 - March 1, 2008

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day POSSESSION LIMIT: 16

RABBIT:

October 13, 2007 - February 28, 2008

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day POSSESSION LIMIT: 16


TRAPPING SEASON:

November 1, 2007 - February 28, 2008

BAG LIMIT: No Limit
