

Chapter 31 Extension Of Service

100 Purpose

The purpose of this regulation was to provide for the extension of service when retirement was mandatory.

101 ~~No application for Extension of Service shall be considered more than 60 days before the date on which the extension is to be effective except in the cases where a contract of employment is required by law to be executed more than 60 days in advance of the effective date for which said extension is requested.~~

~~This Regulation has been superseded by Miss. Code Ann. §25-11-111 (1972, as amended) in which the mandatory retirement age was eliminated effected January 1, 1987 by the Age Discrimination in Employment Act Amendments of 1986 (Public Law 99-592).~~

This Regulation is repealed by the Board of Trustees as the provisions for a mandatory retirement age were eliminated effected January 1, 1987 by the Age Discrimination in Employment Act Amendments of 1986 (Public Law 99-592).
