Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: Recently, the Mississippi Department of Employment Security (hereafter MDES) decided to do a thorough review of its regulations. It was decided after this review, to completely restructure and revamp the entire regulation section. MDES wanted to make the regulations more organized and more user friendly. We also added some pertinent sections. The enclosed regulations are the result of this endeavor.
