AP 2007-38 This administrative policy amendment updates the provider policy manual regarding dental benefits and limitations. A \$2,500 maximum per fiscal year is available for adults and children with additional benefits available with prior authorization. Orthodontia benefits are set at \$4,200 maximum per lifetime per child.
