Subject: Teaching Facilities Billing for Resident Services	Cross Reference: Anesthesia 51.0	

The Division of Medicaid (DOM) does not apply Medicare policy related to billing for services performed by residents in a teaching facility. Residents may not obtain and directly bill DOM under their own provider number for services provided under the direction of the teaching physician.

DOM will accept claims from teaching physicians who are supervising residents. However, DOM requires that services be billed only when the teaching physician is physically present in the room with the beneficiary.

Both the resident and the teaching physician may document services in the beneficiary's medical record. However, the teaching physician must specifically document that he/she was physically present in the room with the beneficiary when services were rendered by the resident.

Providers of anesthesia services should refer to Section 51.04, Criteria for Medical Direction of Residents.
