

**206 Improper Documents.**

(1) A notary shall not notarize a signature:

- (a) on a blank or incomplete document; or
- (b) on a document without notarial certificate wording.

(2) A notary shall neither certify nor authenticate a photograph.

(3) A notary who is not an employee of the issuing government agency shall neither certify nor authenticate a copy of any official government document including but not limited to the following:

- a. Birth Certificate
- b. Death Certificate
- c. Drivers License
- d. Passport
- e. Social Security Card
- f. Any official government issued identity card

Nothing in this section shall prohibit a Notary from notarizing a signature on a document which has a copy of an official government document embedded or attached as an exhibit.
