PUBLIC NOTICE NO. F- 3790

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks at a meeting at John Kyle State Park on August 22, 2007 under authority of Section 25-43-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to, and thirty days thereafter did, adopt the following regulations relative to Lake Bill Waller owned and/or managed by the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks in accordance with Section 49-1-29 as follows:

Be it ordered that the following regulations are adopted for Lake Bill Waller in Marion County which is owned and/or managed by the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. The opening for Lake Bill Waller will be one hour before sunrise on November 14, 2007. Special Youth Lake Opening will be held on November 10, 2007. Youth less than 16 years of age may fish if accompanied by an adult age 21 or older holding a valid fishing license from 6:30 AM – 1:00 PM fish limit, of which no largemouth bass over 18 inches may be kept.

- (1) In addition to any required license, all persons fishing must also have a valid lake permit.
- (2) The boat operator or another person in the boat is required to purchase a combination Launching/Fishing/Skiing permit (permit covers all persons in the boat).
- (3) Pleasure boating and water skiing are not allowed at Lake Bill Waller.

Daily Permits

All annual permits shall be honored for fishing and boat launching on all State Fishing and State Park Lakes owned and operated by the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. All annual permits will expire one year from date of purchase. There are no honor box sales for these permits.

Persons desiring to purchase Senior Citizen permits must show proof of age.

Persons desiring to purchase Disabled permits must provide proof of 100% disability by showing one of the following:

- Railroad Disability Letter that states "100% Disability"
- Veterans Administration Letter stating the person as "100% Service Connected Disability"
- Updated Social Security Form TPQY listing the person as "Disabled Individual".

Boating Rules

- (5) Boats must be operated at idle speed which is any speed that does not produce a wake.
- (6) No aqua-aircraft shall land on any State Fishing Lake without written permission from the Executive Director.
- (7) Swimming and wading are prohibited on Lake Bill Waller.

Fishing Rules

- (8) There shall be FREE FISHING DAYS on all State Fishing and State Park Lakes. These days will be set on all Saturdays and Sundays in National Fishing and Boating Week in June. No permits will be required for fishing on these days; however, participants must comply with state fishing license requirements.
- (9) Creel limit on catfish will be 10 per day in all State Fishing Lakes. Catfish limits during fishing rodeos at state lakes may be different.
- (10) Largemouth bass bag limit is 15 but with maximum size limit of 18 inches. (No LMB 18 inches or larger can be in possession)
- (11) No night fishing. No person shall be permitted on lake property between one hour past sunset and one hour before sunrise.

Other Rules


- 12) Persons who possess a dog or other pet must restrain it on an adequate leash not more than six feet long. Persons allowing animals to disturb other guests will be removed from the lake property. No livestock or other animals, other than horses on designated bridle paths or trails, will be allowed on State Parks or State Lakes except with written permission of the Executive Director of the Mississippi Dept. of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks or his designee.
- (13) Motorized vehicles shall be allowed only in designated areas.
- (14) No firearms are permitted at any time on lake property.
- (15) Other rules for conduct at State Fishing Lakes are listed in Public Notice P11-002.
- (16) Possession of alcohol on state lakes is prohibited.

This adopted public notice will become effective October 23, 2007. Witness my hand and seal this the 21st day of September, 2007.


