

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE ADOPTION

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Specific Legal Authority authorizing the promulgation of Rule: Mississippi Code Ann. § 49-15-15, Administrative Procedures Act, § 25-43-1.101 *et seq.*
Reference to Rules repealed, amended or suspended by the Proposed Rule: No rules have been repealed or suspended. Proposed change to Title 22 Part 7, Chapter 8 Section 102.01 and Chapter 9 Section 100.02 by the Commission on Marine Resources is a change in the recreational and commercial minimum size limit for Spotted Seatrout (*Cynoscion nebulosus*) from 14 inches to 13 inches.

Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: This is a correction to the original filing for proposed change on 10-18-2007. Proposed change to Title 22 Part 7, Chapter 8 Section 102.01 and Chapter 9 Section 100.02 by the Commission on Marine Resources is a change in the recreational and commercial minimum size limit for Spotted Seatrout (*Cynoscion nebulosus*) from 14 inches to 13 inches. TITLE 22 – MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES PART 7 REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE SIZE LIMITS AND BAG LIMITS ON CERTAIN FISH SPECIES AND TO PREVENT SALE OF SEAFOOD BY RECREATIONAL FISHERMEN.

The written request should be submitted to the agency contact person at the above address within twenty (20) days after the filing of this notice of proposed rule adoption and should include the name, address and telephone number of the person(s) making the request; and if you are an agent or attorney, the name, address and telephone number of the party or parties you represent.


