PUBLIC NOTICE NO. F-3795

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks at a meeting at Mahannah Wildlife Management Area on October 31, 2007 under authority of Section 25-43-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt the following regulations relative to Lake Okhissa owned and/or managed by U.S. Forest Service in accordance with Section 49-1-29 as follows:


Be it ordered that regulations stated in Okhissa Lake Closure Order 2007-04-01 (1). Pursuant 116 U.S.C., Section 551, and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 261.50 (a) and (b), are adopted as regulations in their entirety for the area known as Okhissa Lake in Franklin County.

**Fishing Rules**


- (1) Creel limit on catfish will be 10 per day. Catfish limits during fishing rodeos may be different.
- (2) Largemouth bass (LMB) creel limit is 10 (only 1 LMB larger than 20 in. can be in possession). Slot length limit of 16 to 20 inches. (No LMB can be in possession between 16 and 20 inches)
- (3) Bluegill creel limit will be 50 per day.

This adopted public notice will become effective December 1, 2007. Witness my hand and seal this the 31st day of October, 2007.




