Specific Legal Authority authorizing the promulgation of
Rule: Mississippi Code of 1972 Annotated Section 37-13-134

Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:

The Mississippi Department of Education understands the crucial relationship that exists between nutrition and health and nutrition and learning. For that reason, the Mississippi Department of Education intends that: a) school meals will offer healthy food and beverage choices; b) school meals will be prepared in a healthy way; c) school meals will be marketed to include healthy food choices for students and staff; d) school meals will include quality food preparation and products; e) school meals will be served with a consideration of minimum and maximum time allotment for students and staff lunch and breakfast periods; f) school meals will comply with the Mississippi Board of Education Policy on Competitive Foods Sales; and g) efforts will be made to increase participation in the Child Nutrition School Breakfast and Lunch Programs.
