Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:

In August of 2006, the Carl D. Perkins Act was reauthorized. This act is now formally known as The Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Act of 2006 (2006 Perkins Act). To ensure an orderly transition from the 1998 Perkins Act provisions to the new 2006 Perkins Act, the secretary of Education required each state to prepare and submit plans using one of the following options: (1) a six-year State Plan that covered the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2013 or (2) a one-year Transition Plan for the program year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, followed by a five-year State Plan that would cover the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2013. The State of Mississippi chose the one-year transition Plan option, which received State Board approval in May 2007, which would be followed by a five-year State Plan.
