Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:

The Office of the State Auditor is amending the list of items which are exceptions to the rules requiring inventory of items based upon value. This list would be used by agencies, universities, counties, municipalities, and schools. In addition to amending the exception list, the Office of the State Auditor is changing the threshold for equipment items to increase from \$500 (five hundred dollars) to \$1000 (one thousand dollars).
