Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:

AP 2008-21 This administrative policy amendment creates a new section (Section 31.27) that outlines Medicaid's policy on the use of tamper resistant prescription pad/paper. For reimbursement by Medicaid non-electronic prescriptions must be written on tamper-resistant pads/paper. This requirement applies to all outpatient drugs, including over-the-counter drugs. The intent of this policy is to reduce forged, unauthorized and altered prescriptions and to deter drug abuse. Section 31.09 adds Section 31.27 as a cross-reference and updates Medicaid's contact information. Section 53.41 also cross-references section 31.27.


This rule as adopted is without variance from the proposed rule.
