Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:

Pursuant to HB No. 1086, signed by the Governor, during the 2008 Legislative Session, "licensed entity" under §43-11-13 now includes adult foster care facility for the requirement of criminal history record checks. The language referencing the statute was added to the regulatory language in Section 110.03 (1) and (8).
