

106.02 Tuberculosis. All cattle will be required to be negative to a tuberculosis test within 30 days prior to date of shipment, and in addition the cattle must be from a non-quarantined herd in a modified accredited area or tuberculosis-free area.

Exceptions:

1. If cattle entering Mississippi are on a show circuit, a 60-day test is allowed.
2. Cattle originating from an Accredited Tuberculosis Free Herd (Accredited herd number and date accredited shall be entered on health certificate) or Accredited Free State.
3. Steers.
4. Cattle for immediate slaughter.
