Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: The proposed rule will clarify enabling legislation, require instructors to notify Board and students upon cancellation of course, explain internet based system, clarify subsistence costs, strike out “and other pay benefits”, explain adjusting reimbursements based on attendance, strike out “certification, and benefits”, strike out “an approved”, strike out “establishing qualifications for FTO”, clarify that supervisor must request and explain self-paced program, add course vendor to test scoring, strike out “reporting scores to Board”.
