Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: These Rules are adopted by the Secretary of State by the authority granted him in Miss. Code Ann. Section 97-17-71 (2008), hereinafter referred to as the Mississippi Scrap Metal Property Dealer Registration Act ("Act"). The Rules reflect the Secretary of State's efforts to assist Scrap Metal Dealers in meeting the requirements of the Act; they are necessary and appropriate for the public interest and are consistent with the purposes fairly intended by the policy and provisions of the Act. These Rules are intended to supplement and provide guidance under the statutory provisions of the Act and should not be considered as replacing or superseding any provision concerning filings, registrations, applications, penalties, or any other requirements contained therein.

This rule is proposed as a Final Rule, and/or a Temporary Rule (Check one or both boxers as applicable.)


