Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: This new rule is being adopted to implement changes according to Senate Bill 3060 of the 2009 Session of the Mississippi Legislature, Section 79-4-1.22 of the Mississippi Code Ann. (1972), as amended. Beginning January 1, 2010, the fee for filing a corporate annual report with the Mississippi Secretary of State's Office utilizing the on-line filing system will be \$22.00. The fee for filing the annual reports through the mail will remain \$25.00.

This rule is proposed as a Final Rule, and/or a Temporary Rule (check one or both boxes as applicable.)

Persons may present their views on the proposed rule by addressing written comments to the agency at the above address.
