The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on January 19, 2010 under authority of Section 25-43-7, and 49-1-29, of the Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt the following regulations relative to Community Assistance Program water bodies.

Public Notice F5-3550 is hereby repealed. Only rod and reel or line and pole gear may be used in the following public waters which are open to fishing. Unless otherwise stated, all persons possessing a valid fishing license or who are legally exempt from the license requirements may fish these waters. Boating, swimming, littering and alcoholic beverages are not allowed except where noted. City or county ordinances may also regulate activities at these waters.


