The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on April 8, 2010, under authority of Section 25-43-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt the following wildlife management area regulations for the 2010-11 hunting year. This was done under authority of Sections 49-5-13 and 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

Be it ordered that Public Notice W12 3514 is hereby repealed, and the following 2010-11 wildlife management area hunting regulations are adopted.

The WMA is closed to hunting during special event dates (see SPECIAL EVENTS section below).

**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR BLACK PRAIRIE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA
PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT NUMBER W13 3514(I)**

WMA USER PERMIT: All persons using this wildlife management area, except those exempt from purchasing an annual hunting or fishing license, must carry on their person an annual statewide Wildlife Management Area User Permit. This permit is required in addition to the daily visitor use permit and any required license and may be purchased wherever licenses are sold.

BAG LIMITS: Same as statewide bag limits EXCEPT:

Quail - party limit of 8 quail per day.

Turkey - A bag limit of one (1) legal gobbler per permit.

Rabbit - party limit of 8 rabbits per day.

Deer - One legal buck and one legal doe per permit.

PERMIT STATIONS: All visitors must obtain a DAILY VISITOR USE PERMIT card from a self-service permit station. Parts A and B of this permit must be legibly filled out before using the WMA. Part A of the permit must be deposited in the return box at a permit station before using the WMA. Part B must be kept with the visitor while on the WMA. Permits are invalid if not properly dated or if date has been changed. Before leaving the WMA, visitors must complete the reverse side of Part B of the permit and deposit it in the return box at a permit station. It is the responsibility of the Area Manager and other Agency personnel to have permit cards completed.

DEER HUNTING PERMITS: Deer hunting will be allowed by special permit only. You may apply for youth gun and gun permits online at www.mdwfp.com. Only one application will be accepted per hunter for the Black Prairie WMA permitted deer hunt. Hunters may apply for permitted deer hunts on no more than 3 WMAs statewide during the 2010-11 season. Completed applications must be received by Sep. 1, 2010 to be eligible for drawing. Hunters who check in a legal doe during their permitted hunt will be issued a permit to harvest one (1) legal buck. This buck permit will be valid for the duration of the permitted hunt and during the legal bucks only deer hunt (Dec. 27 – Dec.31).

DEER DATA COLLECTION: All deer harvested must be checked at the Area Headquarters by the hunters who harvested them before leaving the WMA. If WMA personnel are not available to check the deer, the hunter is responsible for collecting and legibly recording ALL biological data. Instructions and equipment will be provided.

LEGAL BUCKS: Legal bucks are those with an inside spread of at least 12 inches OR one main beam length of at least 15 inches. For hunters less than 16 years of age, a legal buck may be any buck.

DOG RESTRICTIONS: Deer hunting with dogs is prohibited. Small game hunting with dogs is allowed during any small game season.

TURKEY HUNTING PERMITS: Turkey hunting will be allowed by special permit only. Four 3-day permit turkey hunts will be held (Apr. 1-3, Apr. 8-10, Apr. 15-17, and Apr. 22-24, 2011). A bag limit of one (1) legal gobbler per permit will be enforced. You may apply online at www.mdwfp.com. Only one application will be accepted per hunter for the Black Prairie WMA permitted turkey hunt. Hunters may apply for permitted turkey hunts on no more than 3 WMAs statewide during the Spring 2011 season. Completed applications must be received by Feb. 15, 2011 to be eligible for drawing.

LEGAL WEAPONS: Only centerfire rifles, shotguns with slugs, primitive weapons, and centerfire handguns may be used for deer hunting.

SPECIAL EVENTS: Hunting dog field trails and other special events will be allowed by special use permit only. These permits may be obtained from the MDWFP, see Area Manager for additional information. Special events will be restricted to the following dates: Sep. 25-26, Nov. 6-7, Nov. 11-16, Nov. 19-21, Nov. 25 - Nov. 30, Dec. 4-5, Dec. 8-13, Dec. 16-26, Jan. 1-10, Jan. 21-30, Feb.5 - Feb. 15, Feb. 19-20, Feb. 25 - Mar. 2, and Mar. 6. The WMA is closed to hunting during special event dates. Anyone participating in permitted special events must obey conduct rules as designated and posted by club or group permitted to hold event.

BIRD DOG TRAINING: During bird dog training dates, a person may not use area facilities more than 4 consecutive days.

QUAIL HUNTING PERMITS: Quail hunting from Mar. 3-5 is allowed by special permit only. Hunters wishing to apply must appear in person at the WMA headquarters on Jan. 15, 2011 between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm to complete and submit an application. Only one application per hunter will be accepted. The applications will be entered into the computer and participants will be randomly selected. Hunters who are selected will be notified by mail.

DOVE HUNTING: A youth dove hunt will be held on a designated field Sep. 4, 2010, beginning at 1:00 pm. Dove hunting will be allowed on designated fields after the Sep. 4 youth hunt, beginning at 12:00 noon, on Wednesdays and Saturdays only.

OFF-ROAD MOTORIZED VEHICLES/ATVs: Off-road motorized vehicles/ATVs are only allowed on roads and trails designated for ATV use. Off-road use of ORVs/ATVs is allowed for retrieval of harvested deer. No loaded weapon may be in possession when retrieving harvested game.

HORSES: During WMA deer seasons, horseback riding is restricted to roads open to motorized vehicles. Raccoon hunting from horses is allowed on entire area during nighttime hours.

CAMPING: No camping allowed.

FISHING: Fishing will be permitted on area ponds. Fishing is subject to special regulations posted at each pond. **Boats prohibited.**

BEARS: Black bears may occur on this WMA. They are federally protected as a threatened subspecies. Hunting or disturbing bears is prohibited. Please report any bear sightings on your daily visitor use permit.
