Specific Legal Authority Authorizing the promulgation of Rule:
Miss. Code Ann. Section Miss. Code Ann. § 49-2-9 (1), 49-17-17, 49-17-19, and 49-17-25 (2003).

Reference to Rules repealed, amended or suspended by the Proposed Rule : Upon adoption, will supersede the previous version, which is entitled Mississippi 2008 Section 303(d) List of Impaired Water Bodies.

Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule: The Mississippi 2010 Section 303(d) List of Impaired Water Bodies identifies those waters within the state for which effluent limitations are not sufficient to implement one or more applicable Water Quality Standards and for which Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) are not yet completed.

This rule is proposed as a Final Rule, and/or a Temporary Rule (Check one or both boxes as applicable.)

Persons may present their views on the proposed rule by addressing written comments to the agency at the above address. Persons making comments should include their name and address, as well as other contact information, and if you are an agent or attorney, the name, address and telephone number of the party or parties you represent.

The written request should be submitted to the agency contact person at the above address within twenty (20) days after the filing of this notice of proposed rule adoption and should include the name, address and telephone number of the person(s) making the request; and if you are an agent or attorney, the name, address and telephone number of the party or parties you represent.



List of Impaired Water Bodies

The Federal Clean Water Act Mississippi 2010 Section 303(d) List of Impaired Water Bodies is available for public review and comment. The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) prepared this document in compliance with federal regulations and the Federal Clean Water Act. Water bodies on this list that are impaired are required to have Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) determined for each pollutant added to the water that causes impairment. A TMDL reports the maximum amount of a pollutant that can be put into a stream without violating water quality standards.

A public hearing will be held to receive comments from the public on this draft list on May 11, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. in the MDEQ Commission Hearing Room at 515 Amite Street, Jackson, MS. All comments received during the public notice period and at the public hearing will be considered prior to proposing the list to the Environmental Protection Agency for approval.
