Explanation of the Purpose of the Proposed Rule and the reason(s) for proposing the rule:

The proposed amendment to Regulation 51 conforms the regulation to the statutory change made in S. B. 3083 (2010 Legislative Session), effective July 1, 2010, which provides that upon the death of an active member no more than 30 days of paid personal leave can be reported to PERS and thus used in the calculation of average compensation for determining the retirement allowance. Now, a maximum of 30 days paid leave can be reported to PERS in the event of the death of a member and the same maximum number of days of paid leave will be used in determining the retirement allowance for service retirement, disability retirement, and survivor benefits.

This rule is proposed as a Final Rule, and/or a Temporary Rule
