The 2010 Legislature amended the administrative penalty and procedures for the Petroleum Products Inspection Law. The amended law went into effect July 1, 2010. The Department's current administrative procedures conflict with the law as amended. Therefore, the Department promulgates the attached rule to replace its general rules of procedure as provided for in the law.
