NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PUBLIC NOTICE START DATE: SEPTEMBER 13, 2010

PLEASE TAKE NOTE that the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (“Commission”) is considering a Revision to the State Implementation Plan for Air Pollution Control (SIP Revision) and amendments to state air pollution control regulations. The proposed SIP Revision and regulation amendments will be applicable statewide. The Commission’s authority to adopt the SIP Revision is found at Mississippi Code Annotated Section 49-2-9(1)(b) and Section 49-17-17(b). The Commission’s authority to adopt amendments to the regulations is found at Mississippi Code Annotated Section 49-2-9(1)(b) and Section 49-17-17(i)

I. The proposed actions concern adoption of:

1. Amendments to “Air Emission Regulations for the Prevention, Abatement, and Control of Air Contaminants,” APC-S-1 to adopt, by reference, amendments to Federal New Source Performance Standards, as promulgated in 40 CFR Part 60 and Federal National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants as promulgated in 40 CFR Parts 61 and 63.
2. A SIP Revision and amendments to “Regulations for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality”, APC-S-5 which will incorporate by reference updated relevant portions of federal regulations as promulgated in 40 CFR Parts 51.166, 52.21, and 52.22 in order to make the state Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality permitting program consistent with the federal requirements. Specifically, the proposed amendments will incorporate EPA’s recently promulgated Tailoring Rule for Greenhouse Gases which specifies that beginning in 2011, projects that will substantially increase greenhouse gas emissions will require an air permit. The revision does not incorporate implementation of fine particulate matter that was promulgated on May 16, 2008. The Commission will propose a SIP revision for implementation of fine particulate matter in a separate action at a later date.
3. Amendments to “Air Emissions Operating Permit Regulations for the Purposes of Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act”, APC-S-6, in order to make the Title V permitting program consistent with the federal requirements. Specifically, the proposed amendments will incorporate EPA’s recently promulgated Tailoring Rule.
