

The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on October 22, 2010, under authority of Section 25-43-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, make known its intent to adopt the following regulations relative to Lake Lamar Bruce in Lee Co. in accordance with Section 49-1-29 as follows:

Be it ordered that during the draining of Lake Lamar Bruce all creel and /or size limits will be repealed. All requirements for fishing licenses and /or permits shall remain in full force and effect.


Following the draining of Lake Lamar Bruce, the lake shall be closed to fishing and all activities as scheduled by the Bureau of Fisheries. At such time, appropriate signage shall be placed at all access points on lake property informing the public of the closure.

This adopted public notice will become effective November 22, 2010. Witness my hand and seal this the 22th day of October, 2010.




