CHAPTER 04-Rules Governing The Farmers Market

Operating Guidelines

104 The following guidelines apply to Market operations:

41. No person or organization may solicit money, votes or signatures or engage in a protest, demonstration or political activity/speech, including distribution of written materials, in the Market building or on the sidewalk leading up to or around the building. Such activities must be conducted at least 50 feet from the Market building or in an area specifically designated by the Market Manager. Such person or organization must register with the Market prior to a protest, demonstration or political activity/speech. The Market Manager reserves the right to eject from the grounds any individual who interferes with or disrupts the commerce and operation of the Market.
