All postsecondary career and technical courses offered by community/junior colleges reimbursed with career funds shall be identified and defined by the MS Community College Board. A copy of approved post-secondary courses shall be kept on file at the Mississippi Department of Education.

STATE BOARD POLICY

~~Vocational Courses Designation~~ Post-Secondary Career and Technical Education Course Designations

All postsecondary vocational career and technical courses offered by community/junior colleges and reimbursed with vocational career funds shall carry the appropriate prefixes in their catalogs and/or brochures as outlined in the State Curriculum Framework. Omission of this prefix shall result in the declaring of the course ineligible for reimbursement shall be identified and defined by the MS Community College Board. A copy of approved post-secondary courses shall be kept on file at the Mississippi Department of Education.
