The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on April 18, 2012, under authority of Section 25-43-3.103, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt the following **2012-2013 Small Game Hunting and Trapping Seasons and Bag Limits**. This was done under authority of Sections 49-1-29, 49-5-13 and 49-7-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

Be it ordered that Public Notice Number W16 3433 is hereby repealed and the following Small Game Hunting and Trapping Seasons and Bag Limits are adopted.

FROG:

April 1, 2013 - September 30, 2013

BAG LIMIT: 25

Only 25 may be taken in any one night. A valid hunting or fishing license is required.

RACCOON:

June 30, 2012 - September 30, 2012

BAG LIMIT: 1 per party per night

OPOSSUM, RACCOON, AND BOBCAT:

October 1, 2012 - October 31, 2012 (sport hunting with dogs and guns for food & sport)

BAG LIMIT: 5 per day; 8 per party

November 1, 2012 - February 28, 2012 (sport hunting with dogs and guns for food, sport, and pelt)

BAG LIMIT: No limit

SQUIRREL:

Zone 1: Areas north of Hwy. 82 plus those portions of Sunflower County and Washington County south of Hwy. 82.

September 29, 2012 - February 28, 2013

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Zone 2: Areas between Hwy. 82 and Hwy. 84 plus portions of the state south of Hwy. 84 and west of I-55.

October 13, 2012 - February 28, 2013

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Zone 3: Areas south of Hwy. 84 and east of I-55.

October 27, 2012 - February 28, 2013

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Youth Squirrel Hunts (On private lands and authorized state and federal lands only in those areas open for squirrel hunting)

Zone 1 - September 22- September 28, 2012

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Zone 2 - October 6 - October 12, 2012

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Zone 3 - October 20 - October 26, 2012

BAG LIMIT: 8 per day

Authorized state and federal lands include Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks, U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and U. S. Corps of Engineers managed lands which designate the squirrel youth season in their regulations and open U. S. Forest Service National Forest lands.

Persons eligible to participate in this special hunt are those who are fifteen (15) years of age or younger. A child at least twelve (12) years of age and under sixteen (16) years of age must have a certificate of satisfactory completion of a hunter education course approved by the department before hunting alone in this state; otherwise they must be in the presence and under the direct supervision of a licensed or exempt hunter at least twenty-one (21) years of age when hunting. A child under the age of twelve (12) must be in the presence and under the direct supervision of a licensed or exempt hunter at least

twenty-one (21) years of age when the child is hunting. A licensed hunter supervising a child as provided in this section must hold a valid Mississippi license for the species being hunted.




