
The Mississippi Commission on Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks at a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi on May 16, 2012, under authority of Sections 25-43-7, 49-7-41, 49-7-90 and 49-1-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, made known its intent to adopt the following boat creel limits on crappies for four North Mississippi Reservoirs.

Be it ordered that the following rules and regulations relative to sport fishing on the four North Mississippi Flood Control Reservoirs (Arkabutla, Sardis, Enid and Grenada Lakes) are adopted:


The aggregate daily boat creel limit for all species of crappies (white crappie, black crappie and their hybrids) for boats with 3 or more licensed or exempt anglers, the daily creel limit shall be 50 crappie larger than 12 inches per boat.
