Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: This is a new chapter and rules submitted to explain procedures under the "Mississippi First" law. This law went into effect July 1, 2012 and governs hiring practices for public works projects that utilize funds received by entities resulting from a federally declared disaster/spill of national significance. Under this law, Contractors will be required to post job orders with MDES and these rules provide explanation and clarification of the process.
