Class A	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Hold a bachelor’s degree from a regionally/nationally accredited institution of higher learning</li> <li>2. Pass Praxis I (Pre-Professional Skills Test-PPST)</li> <li>3. Pass Praxis II Specialty Area Test</li> <li>4. Acquire admission to the MAPQT Program. (See Appendix H or <a href="http://www.mde.k12.ms.us/licensure/alternate_path.html">www.mde.k12.ms.us/licensure/alternate_path.html</a>) Complete 90 clock hours of training (times and dates determined by offering college)</li> <li>5. *Apply for the Three Year Educator License – Alternate Route</li> </ol>	3 years	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Complete New Teacher Practicums (Saturdays during first year of teaching)</li> <li>2. Pass evaluation by local school district after first year of teaching</li> <li>3. Complete a local school district mentoring program during first year of teaching</li> <li>4. Apply for a Five Year Alternate Route License</li> </ol>

***\*This license requires an online recommendation from the alternate route program. Once the online recommendation is made, the educator should apply for the license online.***

Class A	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Hold a bachelor's degree (non-education) from a regionally/nationally accredited institution of higher learning</li> <li>2. Pass Praxis I (Pre-Professional Skills Test-PPST)</li> <li>3. Pass Praxis II Specialty Area Test</li> <li>4. Acquire admission to the Teach MS Institute Program (See Appendix H or <a href="http://www.mde.k.12.ms.us/ed_licensure/alternate_path.html">www.mde.k.12.ms.us/ed_licensure/alternate_path.html</a>)</li> <li>5. Complete an eight week training session (see Note) Or eight week online program (times and dates determined by offering colleges/universities)</li> <li>6. *Apply for the Three Year Educator License – Alternate Route</li> </ol>	3 years	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Completion of one year internship period with mentoring and induction program in local school district</li> <li>2. Secure recommendation by school district for continued licensure</li> <li>3. Apply for a Five Year Alternate Route License</li> </ol> <p><i>Note: The eight week university program requires 12 hours of coursework which may be applied toward completing a master's degree.</i></p>

Pass Praxis I (Pre-Professional Skills Test-PPST)</li> <li>3. Pass Praxis II Specialty Area Test</li> <li>4. Apply for entrance into MAT Program (See Appendix H for information)</li> <li>5. Complete 6 hours of pre-teaching courses in an approved MAT Program</li> <li>6. *Secure Verification of Program Completion</li> <li>7. Apply for a Three Year Educator License – Alternate Route</li> </ol>	3 years	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Secure a teaching position</li> <li>2.
