Short explanation of rule/amendment/repeal and reason(s) for proposing rule/amendment/repeal: As a result of the requirement of all licensed residential builders, remodelers or roofers to carry general liability insurance, the proposed amendment clarifies the insurance disclosure statement between a residential builder, remodeler or roofer and a purchaser and further requires the residential builder, remodeler or roofer to specify the insurer and policy number within the disclosure.


