Rule 1.3 Traffic Control at Public Parks of the District.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to enter Lakeshore Park, Old Trace Park or Pelahatchie Shore Park or any other public park of the District where a toll gate is maintained and attended unless the operator or other occupant of the vehicle shall first have paid to the toll gate attendant a traffic fee as posted at the toll gate, not to exceed \$5.00 per vehicle, for each entrance into such park, provided that a vehicle for which a traffic fee has been paid may within the same calendar day be allowed to leave and enter such park one time without paying a second fee. An annual permit for access to the above mentioned parks may be purchased for a fee not to exceed \$30.00 per year. The annual fee covers access to all parks and unlimited return visits within one calendar year.

(b) Traffic fees shall be collected, at all times during which the toll gate is attended throughout the year as the General Manager may determine.

(c) The term "vehicle" as used in this regulation shall mean without limitation every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported upon a street or highway, except nonmotorized devices designed to be moved solely by human power, and shall include without limitation, automobiles, trucks, jeeps, motorcycles, all terrain vehicles (ATV), off road vehicles, motor bikes, buses, vans, dirt bikes, and three-wheelers.

(d) Each violation of this regulation shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
