



Briefly summarize the benefits that may result from this regulation and who will benefit: Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus (PEDv) is a highly contagious disease, and has resulted in the death of over 7 million pigs within the US over the past 12 months. Implementation of this rule will increase the ability of the Board of Animal Health respond to potential outbreaks of disease and save the swine industry of Mississippi economic losses.
2. Briefly describe the need for the proposed rule:
May of 2013 a disease new to the United States was diagnosed and since has spread to most states called PEDv, resulting in millions of animals lost and an increase in cost of pork meat to the consumer. This is a highly contagious disease requiring rapid response to mitigate the losses to industry.

Implementation of this rule will allow the Board of Animal Health to more rapidly respond to disease outbreak, and to mitigate losses to swine producers within the state.


