

TITLE 22 – MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES, PART 9 Rules and Regulations for Statistical Reporting and Confidentiality of Statistical Data for Marine Fisheries in the State of Mississippi

Chapter 11:

100 Persons engaged in recreational fishing in waters under the jurisdiction of the MDMR or landing fish in Mississippi shall be required to furnish information, including a harvest report, pertaining to such fishing when as requested by to an information confidentiality officer. The owner or captain of any vessel recreationally harvesting red snapper is hereby required to complete a harvest report by the MDMR.

101 Charter boat or head boat captains operating in Mississippi waters will shall be required to complete questionnaires furnished by the MDMR for each trip. Completed questionnaires will shall be furnished to an information confidentiality officer upon request.
