Election Results

Congratulations on the successful completion of the 2009 municipal election cycle! The elections are complete, and in concluding the process, we want to remind elections officials that you must provide the Secretary of State with results from both your primary and general elections.

Primary and primary run-off results must be certified by the appropriate municipal executive committee and transmitted to our office within five (5) days after the election. Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-611. General election results must be certified by the municipal election commission and transmitted to our office within five (5) days after the election. Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-611. If your municipality has not yet provided us with certified results from the primary or primary run-off, please do so immediately.

We understand some municipalities did not hold primary or general elections due to lack of candidate opposition. In the event your municipality was not required to hold a general election, you must provide us with a resolution of the municipal election commission dispensing with the election and declaring the winners of the election. Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-361.

Lastly, residual vote reports must be submitted to our office after each election. Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-613. The reports are prepared by the municipal party executive committees for the primary and primary run-off elections and the municipal election commission for the general election. Please encourage your executive committees or election commission to review Miss. Code Ann. § 23-15-613 for further reporting requirements. Residual reports are available on our website and must be received in the Secretary of State's office no later than December 15, 2009. We encourage all municipalities to submit residual reports as soon as possible.
