

PROCLAMATION OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Mississippi, lawfully assembled in Regular Session in 2002, did adopt Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 522 proposing an amendment to the Mississippi Constitution concerning appointments by the Governor to the Board of Learning and requiring that they be made from the Supreme Court Districts; and

WHEREAS, said resolution required the amendment be submitted to the qualified electors of the State of Mississippi at a general election to be held on November 4, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, following the mandate of Section 273 of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, gave public notice of said election as therein required at least thirty (30) days preceding the date thereof and under the provisions of Mississippi Code Annotated Section 7-3-39 (1972), published said proposed constitutional amendment in full in each county in each of the respective counties of the State two (2) weeks prior to the said election; and WHEREAS, at the election the qualified electors of this state voted in favor of said amendment 588,444 qualified electors voted directly for said amendment and 102,020 qualified electors voted directly against said amendment; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned does hereby certify that the said amendment was approved by the majority of the qualified electors of the State of Mississippi as required by the Constitution

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ERIC CLAY, Secretary of State of the State of Mississippi, by authority vested in me by Section 273 of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, do hereby issue my official proclamation inserting new language in said

Constitution, amending the said Constitution
Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 522, to wit:

Amend Section 213-A, Mississippi Con-

Section 213-A. The state institutions of higher learning * * * in Mississippi, to wit: University of Mississippi, Mississippi State University, Mississippi University of Applied Science, Mississippi University of Commerce, Mississippi University of Southern Mississippi, Delta State University, Alcorn State University, Mississippi Valley State University, and any others * * * which may be * * * organized or established by the State of Mississippi, shall be under the management and control of a board of trustees to be known as the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning. The * * * Governor * * * shall appoint the members of the board with the advice and consent of the Senate. The Governor shall appoint only persons who are qualified electors residing in the district from which each is appointed and of the highest order of intelligence and performance of such duties, to the end that the members of the board shall perform their honorable duties * * * to the greatest benefit of the state and its educational institutions, uninfluenced by any political considerations. The board of trustees shall be composed of twelve (12) members. The members of the board of trustees as constituted on January 1, 2004, shall continue to serve until the expiration of their respective terms of office. Appointments made to fill vacancies created by expiration of term after January 1, 2004, shall be as follows: The initial term of the members appointed in 2004 shall be for eleven (11) years; the initial term of the members appointed in 2008 shall be for ten (10) years; and the initial term of the members appointed in 2012 shall be for nine (9) years. After the expiration of the initial terms, all terms shall be for nine (9) years. Four (4) members of the board of trustees shall be appointed from each of the three (3) Mississippi Supreme Court districts and, as such vacancies occur, the Governor shall make appointments from the Supreme Court district having the smallest number of board members until the membership includes four (4) members from each

of the State of Mississippi as provided by

the Constitution of 1890, to read as follows:

Section 213-A. The state institutions of higher learning * * * in Mississippi, to wit: University of Mississippi, Mississippi State University, Mississippi University of Applied Science, Mississippi University of Commerce, Mississippi University of Southern Mississippi, Delta State University, Jackson State University, Alcorn State University, Mississippi Valley State University, and any others * * * which may be organized or established by the State of Mississippi, shall be under the management and control of a board of trustees to be known as the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning. The * * * Governor * * * shall appoint the members of the board with the advice and consent of the Senate. The Governor shall appoint only persons who are qualified electors residing in the district from which each is appointed and of the highest order of intelligence and character, learning and fitness for the performance of such duties, to the end that such board shall perform its high and honorable duties * * * to the greatest benefit of the people of the state and such educational institutions, uninfluenced by any political considerations. The board of trustees shall be composed of twelve (12) members. The members of the board of trustees as constituted on January 1, 2004, shall continue to serve until the expiration of their respective terms of office. 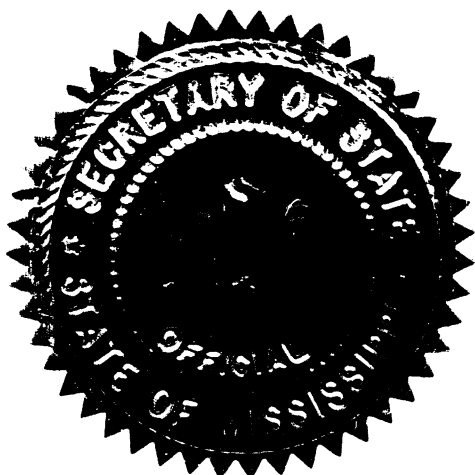
