
PETITIONERS would show pursuant to copy of page 2 of the Official Recapitulation, attached and marked as Exhibit "A" totals certified for candidate Billy Blackburn was 10,443 and totals certified for candidate Phil Bryant was 2,377 when in fact the number of votes received by each candidate was listed in precinct order correctly but the "total votes number" was transposed and the certified total should reflect candidate Billy Blackburn as receiving 2,377 and candidate Phil Bryant as receiving 10,443.

PETITIONERS would further show pursuant to Attorney General's opinion to Lawrence, Mann December 6, 1988 that in order to correct an error (of certified results) a Court of competent jurisdiction must enter an order.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners now pray that the Circuit Court of Pearl River County would enter Order to Correct the Certified Results of the Official Recapitulation certified to the

Secretary of State of the State of Mississippi on the 12th day of November, 2003 for the

RESULTS OF NOVEMBER 4, 2003 GENERAL ELECTION

THIS DAY this matter came on for hearing on Petition of the Pearl River County Election Commissioners, consisting of Idora White, District One; Margaret Woodson, District Two; Beatrice Bond, District Three; Bobby Robbins, District Four; and Hilda Owen, District Five; for an Order to correct the error of transposed totals in the contest of State Auditor in the Official Recapitulation certified to the Secretary of State for the State of Mississippi on the 12th day of November, 2003 for the General Election held on the 4th day of November, 2003, and based on the matters proffered, the Court finds as follows;

The Circuit Court of Pearl River County is a Court of competent jurisdiction and has jurisdiction over this matter.

The Court further finds that the total votes certified in the race of State Auditor for candidate Billy Blackburn was shown as 10,443 and total votes certified for candidate Phil Bryant was 2,377 when in fact the number of votes received by each candidate was listed in precinct order correctly but the "total votes number" was transposed and should be corrected to reflect candidate Billy Blackburn as receiving 2,377 and candidate Phil Bryant as receiving 10,443.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that Honorable Eric Clark, Secretary of State for the State of Mississippi be and is hereby directed to correct the certified results of the Official Recapitulation Results for Pearl River County, Mississippi in the contest of State Auditor to reflect that Billy Blackburn received 2,377 and Phil Bryant received 10,443.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Circuit Clerk of Pearl River County mail a certified copy of this order to Honorable Eric Clark, Secretary of State for the State of Mississippi.
