

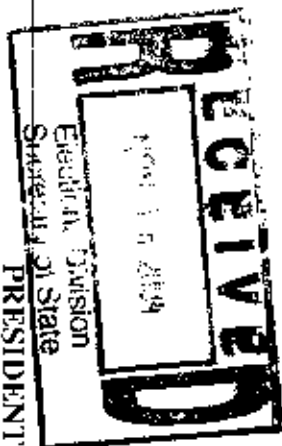
Official Recapitulation
