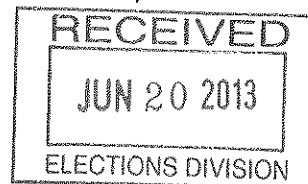

THEREUPON, the Mayor of the Town of Falkner directed that a quorum was present for the transaction of business.

IN RE: APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ORDER IN RE: RECESS

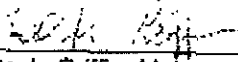

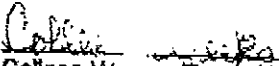
