

Ladies and Gentlemen:

At a meeting of the Town of Lula Municipal Election Commission, after certifying the candidates for mayor, five aldermen, and town clerk, we realized that each candidate is running unopposed. We contacted the town clerk to discuss our findings. We suggested to him that we did not see the need to hold an election and spend unnecessary town funds when there was no opposition in any seat. As we are not totally abreast of the procedure in this particular situation, Mr. Hosemann's Secretary of State office was contacted to seek advice on how to proceed.

As a result of the conversation, we found that the state election board is in agreement. Therefore, it is the recommendation of this commission that we do not hold a municipal election this term. Having been stated, we petition the mayor and board of aldermen to accept our decision in this matter and vote not to hold an election in June.

ORDER TO DISCUSS AND OR HIRE TOWN ATTORNEY


